District Profile

Rasuwa District is a part of Province No. 3, is one of the seventy-five districts of Nepal, a landlocked country Nepal, South Asia. The district, with Dhunche as its district headquarters, covers an area of 1,544 km² and has a population (2011) of 43,300. As per census 2011 total households in Rasuwa district is 9,778. It is the smallest district by area, among 16 districts in the *Himalayan* region of Nepal.

Program

HURON conducted training program in Dunche of Rasuwa District on 28th November, 2017. The program began at 9 am. The opening ceremony was chaired by Chief District Officer of Rasuwa District. During the inaugural Ceremony Armed Police force, district police officers, politicians etc. were attended. The training program began at 10 am. During the program, there were five representatives each from district office, district police and armed police force. Altogether there were 45 people attended at the training program. The training facilitators were Dr. Govind Pd. Dhakal and HURON President Indra Prasad Aryal.

The main topic of facilitation were Fundamental rights of Nepal, International Laws and Treaties, Gentlemen's agreement, Good Governance, Federalism, Civil Rights, Crisis Management and Sustainable Development Goals.

There were total 45 participants where HURON members, Media Personnel, Security personnel (Nepal police and Armed Police Force), Political Party Representatives, students, teachers, NGOs were attended. Out of 45 participants 15 were female and 30 were male.
